PERSONAL PACKING LIST

- Bible
- A flexible and servant-like heart and attitude!
- Sleeping bag or sheets
- Pillow
- Soap
- Shampoo/conditioner
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush/toothpaste (we have some, but to play it safe bring some)
- Towel
- Mask (good in case local rules change or homeowner prefers)
- Insect repellent (only if the person is normally bug bane)
- Sunscreen
- Twin-size air mattress (depending on gender breakdown, this may be needed as the warehouse has an 8 bed area and a 14 bed area - if the gender breakdown doesn't fit this number, then we will use a church classroom to house some of your team. If you send me the gender breakdown, I will let you know my recommendation)
- Copy of your medical insurance card

CLOTHES:

- Work clothes
- Long-sleeved shirts for November-April - weather has been great, but one long-sleeved shirt wouldn't hurt
- Long pants and/or cargo shorts - either is fine, but cargo shorts are what the construction guys are wearing
- Casual clothes for evening times and traveling
- Sweater, sweatshirt, or light jacket in season (personal preference if someone runs cold)
- Modest sleeping clothes
- Raingear - I'd skip
- Hat - up to the person
- Versatile walking shoes - can be the same as work shoes, just one pair must be closed toed.
- Work shoes (Tennis shoes are acceptable; steel toes are optional)
- Flip-flops for showers or evenings

Optional:

- Gift cards to donate to the ministry from Lowes, Home Depot, Wal-Mart etc.
- Caterade dry mix or bottles
